





The Motherlode "Connection"


Dave and Doug Gave us the program over view on the MotherLode Connection retreat. A fee based mining opportunity in California on PRIVATE property that they are setting up. This is old Virgin river channel with a great deal of potential.

From now through Feb 2010 this plan is being offered to members of the Portland GPAA club. There are two plans. Both are for 5 weeks of prospecting, 1 week each year for 5 years. Keep all of the gold that you find!

Plan A – Heavy equipment and a trommel are included. Cost is \$10,000.

Plan B – You provide your own equipment.

With both plans you will provide your own food, lodging (RV), fuel and transportation. They presented a non-binding contract with no money exchanged until the minimum capital is committed to the project.
