Safety TIPS

Last month we talked about the safety of water in the outdoors that may be contaminated with bacteria. This month we will discuss the need for water (hydration) while working outdoors in hot conditions. The body cools itself by sweating and allowing that sweat to evaporate. This requires enough fluid in the body to make sweat, air circulating across the skin, and low enough air humidity to allow that sweat to evaporate. Activity in a hot climate can overwhelm the body's ability to cool itself, causing heat-related symptoms.

Heat exhaustion may affect people who are prospecting outdoors on a very hot day.

Most of us have heard the symptoms of heat exhaustion such as:

- Profuse sweating
- Weakness
- Muscle cramps
- Headache
- Nausea and vomiting

As dehydration increases from the loss of body water, lightheadedness may occur and fainting may happen if the person stands up quickly. A low grade fever also may be present. (More next month)
