If you win you will get a tiny vial of gold and you will get 1 ticket to possibly win a 1-gram gold nugget. We will be raffling off 5 big prizes and the tickets will be \$5. The prizes will be a Gold Nugget, Metal detector, Gold Prospecting Kit, Silver Morgan Dollars and 1 other prize. Monday after the show we will draw the winning ticket for the Gold Nugget. Portland Gold Prospectors Inc Bottle drop fundraiser.

The OBRC Bottle Drop Blue Bag Program allows you to easily donate the deposit value of your recyclable bottles and cans to local nonprofits. Simply fill a Blue Bag with eligible containers and drop it off at a participating Bottle Drop location to support your chosen cause.

How to Donate

- 1. Get a Blue Bag: Available at Club meetings and at Prospector's Treasure Trove.
- 2. Fill the Bag: Collect eligible beverage containers (see below for details) and fill the Blue Bag.
- 3. **Drop Off**: Drop the full bag off at any <u>Bottle Drop location</u>. We receive a bonus when these are returned to a bottle drop attached to a retail store.
 - a. Only Bottle Drop Blue Bags are accepted and they must have the non profit's barcode sticker attached.
 - b. Scan the bag tag to open the secure Drop Door.
- Or Donate Your Personal Bottle Drop Account Balance: If you have a Bottle Drop account from
 personal drop offs, you can donate your balance directly to a nonprofit via the Bottle Drop app or
 website.
 - a. From your bottle drop account: select "for individuals" then "Make non-profit Donations" then search for "portland gold"

Eligible Containers

- Accepted: Glass, plastic, and aluminum bottles and cans with a 10¢ deposit (e.g., water, soda, beer).
 - o **Oregon Refund Value**: Knowingly returning containers that do not have an Oregon refund value may result in a fine.
- Size: Containers must be between **0.5** and **3** liters.
- Not Accepted: Non-refundable items like wine, dairy based drinks, or food jars.

Get Started

- 1. Pick up a Blue Bag at any Bottle Drop location.
- 2. Fill it with eligible containers.
- 3. Drop it off at Bottle Drop and watch your donation grow!
